

Update: Beginning May 31, 2024, we will no longer allow the bring your own wine option for cooking classes which include any level of hands-on participation. Wine will be available for purchase by the bottle or glass.

Demonstration Only Classes and most Chef's Table Events will be excluded from this policy.

Though most of our students and guests have been respectful enough to follow our previous alcohol policy for hands-on classes, unfortunately, the instances of students skirting this policy and overindulging have become frequent and unmanageable.

Hands-on cooking classes have a lot of moving parts. While we try to keep the class flowing smoothly, teaching, answering questions, and resetting each lesson, we cannot prioritize managing the drinking habits of each student or counting how many byo bottles were brought in.

Overindulging not only disrupts the class, and those who are here to learn, but also becomes a safety risk to all during hands-on participation.

Wine will be available for purchase by the bottle or by the glass from our self-serve wine machine. We have an amazing selection of Italian wines. With this option, everyone will still have the opportunity to enjoy some great wine during class, while allowing us to ensure the hands-on class will run smoothly and safely.
